1. Relationship

Contractor and Client agree that the "work for hire" relationship is the only defined relationship between the two, and that Client does not consider Contractor to be an employee. As such, Client is not required to provide benefits, including insurance, paid vacation, or sick leave, to Contractor.

Contractor further agrees to waive {h/her} right to hold Client responsible for any injuries that occur as a result of Work during the duration of this contract.

6. Confidentiality

Contractor understands that entering into this Contract with Client means that Contractor will possibly come into contact and/or learn about privileged information pertaining to Client. Contractor agrees not to divulge any of this confidential information to any third party without

the expressed written consent of Client. Failure to keep such information private could result in legal action on the part of Client, and/or revocation of the terms of this Contract.

7. Ownership and Copyright

Contractor agrees that any Work {heshe} creates for the Client during the length of this Contract shall belong entirely to the Client. This includes any copyrights that pertain to the Work, since the work will be "made for hire" as defined by the United States Copyright Act.

8. Termination
